Quick Tip!
It is very important to establish classroom rules on the first day of school. But what is the best way to get your students to adhere to these rules? By encouraging them to contribute to the development of these rules, your students will feel empowered. Start off listing 1 or 2 MUSTS, such as, "Respect other people and their property." Remember to phrase these rules in the positive rather than negative. Now comes the chance to brainstorm with your students. Below are some suggested rules that could be topics for class discussion.

- *Come prepared bringing your books and everything you need for class unless told otherwise.*
- *Come to class and hand in assignments on time.*
- *Be seated at your desk and ready to work when the school bell rings.*
- *Use indoor voices in class. Do not disturb people who are working.*
- *Listen carefully and follow directions.*
- *Raise your hand and wait to be called on before speaking.*
- *Always do your best.*
