Program Structure

9:00–9:30

The day begins with Tefillah and Learning. There is no charge for this segment and we strongly encourage you to include this in your child's schedule.

9:30–12:30

Classes and workshops are held at 9:30–10:30, 10:30–11:30, and 11:30–12:30.

12:30–1:00

Lunch is served at 12:30 pm followed by bentching and dismissal at 1:00 pm. Once again, free hot lunches will be offered. Details will be available after June 1.

1:00–4:00

Campers who have registered for the afternoon trip option will be dismissed at 4:00 pm.

Program Costs and Fees

- ☀ Tefillah and Learning (9:00–9:30)—No Charge
- ☀ Classes and Workshops (9:30–12:30)—\$100 for **each hourly class**. This includes a \$30 supply fee. Class changes made after the 2nd day of the program will incur an additional supply fee.
- ☀ Lunch—No Charge
- ☀ Afternoon Programming (1:00–4:00):
 - Trips Deluxe:** A five/day week trip package—\$300
 - Trips:** A three day/week trip package—\$180
 - Mini Trips:** A two day/week trip package—\$120
- ☀ A full day trip will be held during each session for all campers at no extra cost. In addition, a night trip will be held, separately for boys and girls, at an additional fee.

Administrative fee is \$75. If you register for both sessions at once, there is only one fee.

Late fees: 3/15/10–5/15/10 \$50. After 5/15/10 \$100

Please note that all balances from previous summers must be paid in full before registration will be accepted. Thank you!

A \$100 deposit is required with all registrations.

Deposit and late fees are non-refundable.

Discounts, Early Bird Bonus Trips and Scholarships:

A 50% discount is applied for children of full-time teachers in the ATT system. A 10% discount is offered to siblings of a registered camper. These discounts do not apply to registration, supply, or administrative fees.

These discounts are available until March 15, 2010 only, no exception will be made. Two bonus trips on June 23rd and June 24th will be offered to campers who register by March 15, 2010. Those who register after March 15th may participate for \$18 per trip.

Limited scholarships are available on a need basis. Registration and deposit must be submitted along with a scholarship application by March 15, 2010. Scholarship applications are available at the ATT office.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation prior to March 15 will be refunded in full, less the \$75 administrative fee. After March 15, the \$100 deposit will be held as well. No refunds will be given after June 1.

Orientation

Orientation for campers and parents will be held Tuesday, June 22 at the ATT.
